JOB DISCRIPTION

SAFETY

Maintain a safe and inclusive environment, ensuring that all campers are following safety guidelines and that equipment is used properly.

FOSTERING RELATIONSHIPS

Build rapport with campers, creating a positive and encouraging environment safe for learning and growth.

ACTIVE SUPERVISION

Ensure campers are engaged, supervised, and accounted for at all times during activities, free time, and meals.

TEAMWORK & SPORTSMANSHIP

Instill values of teamwork, respect, and fair play in all activities.

PROMOTE GROWTH MINDSET

Provide encouragement and constructive feedback to campers to help them develop their athletic skills and self-confidence.

ROLE MODEL

Exhibit professionalism, responsibility, and a positive attitude at all times.

QUALIFICATIONS

AGE

Must be at least 16 years old, or entering 11th grade.

EXPERIENCE

Previous experience working with children in a sports, coaching, or camp setting is preferred but not required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to actively participate in sports and activities.
- Ability to stand, walk, run, and lift moderate amounts of weight (e.g., sports equipment).
- Capable of spending time outdoors in varying weather conditions.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced, dynamic, and high-energy environment.

SKILLS

- Strong communication and leadership skills.
- A passion for sports and working with children.
- Ability to work as part of a team.

CERTIFICATIONS

First Aid and CPR certification (or willingness to obtain before camp starts).
